"JAMIE WYETH DONATES PAINTED WINE BOTTLE FOR MEALS ON WHEELS DELAWARE'S CELLAR MASTERS' WINE AUCTION"

March 30, 2016—On April 16, 2016, Meals On Wheels Delaware will host the 12th Annual Cellar Masters' Wine Auction at the Wilmington Country Club. Guests will enjoy passed hors d'oeuvres, an upscale multi-course seated dinner, specialty wine pours, live and silent auctions, and entertainment. In 2015, the auction raised over \$100,000 to benefit Meals On Wheels programs for homebound seniors.

He is well known in the artistic community for creating the official White House Christmas cards, under the commission of President Reagan. Wyeth's art is displayed in many public collections, such as the National Gallery of Art and the John F. Kennedy Library. He is also a beloved illustrator of children's books.

The exceptional offering of Wyeth's hand painted bottle will be the crowning glory of the live auction. "Jamie has painted bottles for our auction on two separate occasions, and when asked to participate one more time, he accepted without hesitation," said Vaughn Hardin, Meals On Wheels Delaware Board Member and Cellar Masters' Wine Auction Chair. "This will likely be the last time you will ever see something like this. We are so fortunate to have a sold out event, so we have decided to take absentee bids in order to best serve our homebound seniors."

Meals On Wheels Delaware is accepting sealed bids from the public until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 8, 2016. The highest bidder at this time will be invited to attend the event with a guest, or call in to participate in bidding during the live auction.
