We were pleased to work with MOWD and receive financial support to assist in the delivery of meals to approximately 1,600 seniors on a daily basis. As a member of the MOWD Board of Directors, I was there when Ajit George and Jim Thornton proposed a 'Meals From the Masters' Brunch in Wilmington, held at the MBNA Headquarters. That event was a tremendous success.

In 2008, a similar event was proposed for Kent County. MOWD Board Member, Eleanor Cain recruited leadership in Kent County to create Denim and Diamonds. Held at the Delaware Agriculture Museum, the event reflected the rural roots of central Delaware. Also a success, it led to what is now Sip and Savor, which continues to be an important source for funding for MOWD.
