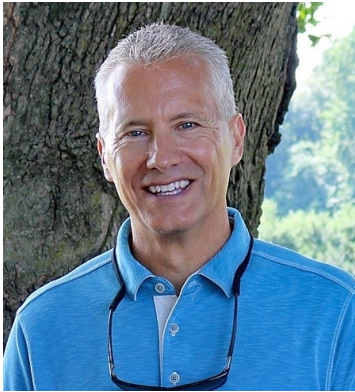

We were excited to join CHEER senior services at the Georgetown Community Center, on February 17, 2023. We were invited to celebrate the first day in service of their new Meals On Wheels van. The purchase was made possible by donations to Meals On Wheels Delaware. As the van says Together We Can End Senior Hunger.

CHEER centers are a service hub for many seniors in Sussex County. Each weekday the kitchen staff in the Georgetown Center, begin their day long before sunrise to prepare and package close to 1,000 freshly prepared Meals On Wheels. Once the meals are packaged they are loaded into a van just like this, to be transported to a location where volunteers pick up the meals and bring them the last mile or so the seniors door.
