Here are some statistics for our great state from the Delaware Population Consortium.

- \cdot 29% of the population of Delaware are seniors over the age of 60.
- \cdot The number of Delaware residents 85 and over will increase by 51%, in the next 15 years.
- Seniors 75 plus make up the largest percentage of those who need help with a home-delivered meal.
- Among seniors 65 and over 26% are living alone, according to the latest census information. Meals on Wheels provides a freshly prepared meal, and a friendly face to seniors in need.
