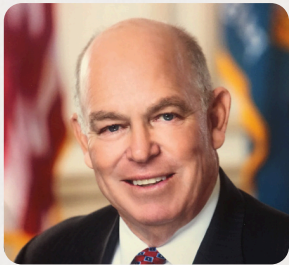

BOARD MEMBER SPOTLIGHT



Pete Schwartzkopf is the former Speaker of the Delaware House of Representatives. He served as Majority Leader for four years before being elected Speaker of the House in 2012, and served through June 2023.

He represented the 14th district from 2002 through 2024. The 14th district includes Rehoboth, Lewes, and Dewey Beach. Pete is a retired Delaware State Police Captain and Troop Commander with 25 years of service. He graduated from Wilmington College with a BS in Human Resource Management. He graduated from Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command and was first in his class at the Delaware State Police Academy.

Pete is active with several non-profit organizations including the Delaware Special Olympics, the Midway Lions Club, the Delaware State Troopers Association, the National Kidney Foundation (having donated an organ), and the Jean & Joan Fund which raises money to help families and patients who are being treated at Tunnell Cancer Center.

Delaware's coastal communities have always held a special place in his heart. These days, Pete, and his wife Carol enjoy spending time with their children and grand-children while taking advantage of all the First State has to offer to residents and visitors alike.
